THE TRUTH WILL SET YOU FREE. KING HEROD, HERODIAS AND JOHN THE BAPTIST


Jesus said at the Last Supper "I am the Way, the Truth and the Life".

John the Baptist lived the truth – the life of God was in him. King Herod liked the Truth, but could not bring himself to live it. He liked the Truth because he did not initially kill John – he kept him in prison and protected him from death.

Herodias wanted John dead – the life of God's Truth was dead in her but not quite dead in Herod yet. In another part of the Gospel we are told that

Herod liked to bring John up out of the dungeon and he would listen to what John had to say. The truths that John told him intrigued the King and interested him but they also disturbed them.

It is like that for us too. We all have a natural inclination to love what is true, authentic and sincere and to despise what is insincere, inauthentic and untrue. Even


