Last week saw the beginning of the 'Year of Faith' which is an ideal opportunity for us all to reflect on our relationship with God. GALLERY NEWS

The composition "Rain Falling Up" is by Belfast born Brian Irvine. The modern oratorio will be performed in the Convention Theatre on November 10th. Brian writes "there is nothing finer or more exhilarating....than leaping headlong ... into the odd shaped legoland we call music..." This is the work the choir is now engaged in learning and an opportunity for others to join in the worthwhile venture.

The lovely responsorial psalm Occuli Nostri, sung at Communion, is taken from the Taize collection of hymns. This type of composition goes back to antiquity and is found in many examples of chants. The sea shanty is another example of sung response. When work was mostly done by manual labour it was often accompanied by singing a repeated rhythmic phrase. It not only helped to alleviate the tedium of the day but also served as a means of supplying a steady pulse on ongoing tasks.
