Over the next coming days over 300 young adults from the Archdiocese of

Dublin are flying out to Krakow for the World Youth Day.

In Krakow these young adults will experience church in a different way – they join with two million young adults from all over the world to reflect, pray, celebrate and be together. Five young adults, Ciara Armstrong, Sean Nolan, Sophie Shannon, Emily O'Reilly and Natasha Doherty are representing the CCPC in Krakow. Over the past ten months these young parishioners have been journeying with other pilgrims from the Archdiocese and on Monday we will gather at Dublin airport to fly to Krakow. As part of the diocesan team I have been planning this pilgrimage for over 16 months and finally on Monday it is all coming together when we gather in the Chapel of Ease at the airport.

The Church is very much alive! I am very proud to be part of this youth event for the fourth time. I attended the World Youth Days in Toronto, Cologne, Madrid and now Krakow. For myself these gathering are magical as it shows a different side of Church. You might have heard people saying that the Young Church is dead – or the Young adults do not practise! I promise you the last year and a half have proved the opposite! The Church is very much alive! Every time the pilgrims gathered the Spirit was alive! These young adults are full of energy and are not afraid to stand up for what they believe is right!



This week's gospel is about "how to pray". Sometimes we find it hard to find the right words for prayers. That where Jesus makes it easy! He taught us the "Our Father". Our prayer should not stop there, He adds "ask and it will be given to you, search and you will find, knock and the door will be opened for you".

I ask God this week to please watch over the young adults attending the World Youth Day. I pray that we will experience His love for us. CLONDALKIN MEN'S SHED

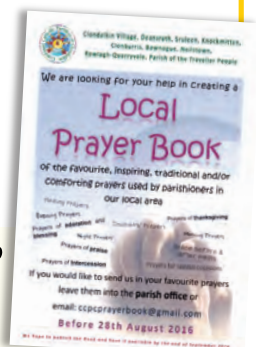
We were re-launched on 22nd June

The first WYD took place in 1984 in Rome. Over 300,000 young people from around the world responded to the invitation from the late John Paul II for an International Jubilee of youth on Palm Sunday in St. Peter's square. Looking out to the crowds who answered his invitation he said, "What a fantastic spectacle is presented on this stage by your gathering here today! Who claimed that today's youth has lost their sense of values? Is it really true that they cannot be counted on?" Since 1984 WYD has been celebrated all over the world.

Over 26 Million Young people have celebrated WYD.

The Archdiocese of Dublin has a great tradition of bringing pilgrims to World Youth Days.
