Over the next coming days over 300 young adults from the Archdiocese of

Dublin are flying out to Krakow for the World Youth Day. In Krakow these young adults will experience church in a different way — they join with two million young adults from all over the world to reflect, pray, celebrate and be together. Five young adults, Ciara Armstrong, Sean Nolan, Sophie Shannon, Emily O'Reilly and Natasha Doherty are representing the CCPC in Krakow. Over the past ten months these young parishioners have been journeying with other pilgrims from the Archdiocese and on Monday we will gather at Dublin airport to fly to Krakow. As part of the diocesan team I have been planning this pilgrimage for over 16 months and finally on Monday it is all coming together when we gather in the Chapel of



The first WYD took place in 1984 in Rome. Over 300,000 young people from around the world responded to the invitation from the late John Paul II for an International Jubilee of youth on Palm Sunday in St. Peter's square. Looking out to the crowds who answered his invitation he said, "What a fantastic spectacle is presented on this stage by your gathering here today! Who claimed that today's youth has lost their sense of values? Is it really true that they cannot be counted on?" Since 1984 WYD has been celebrated all over the world. Over 26 Million Young people have celebrated WYD. The Archdiocese of Dublin has a great tradition of bringing pilgrims to World Youth Days.
