**WE ARE CHURCH!**

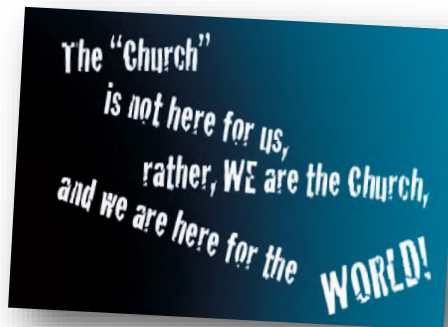


On more than one occasion Pope Francis has surprised people by asking,

**“Hands up to those who know the date you were baptised”.**

He asks this because he is convinced that the date of our baptism is the most important day of our lives - a date few of us know!

On that date we became part of the Church — “the people of God” as the Vatican Council called us. Pope Francis points out that we were baptised as lay people — yes a few of us became priests and religious and special helpers in our parishes — but the majority of us witness to our Christian calling in our homes, places of work and play or as we say ‘in our ordinary lives’



We are Church in our homes, our factories, offices, schools, shops, banks, hospitals, playing fields and in all places where we live out our lives. That is where we relate, live and act in line with the values and attitudes of Jesus. That is where we, by our way of life, prepare others to welcome God into our lives.

That is what Jesus is doing in today’s Gospel story “when he appointed seventy two others, and sent them out ahead of him, in pairs, to all the towns and villages he himself was to visit”. These seventy two represent all of us. As spouses, parents, teachers, ministers of the Church community, friends, political or civil leaders we open the way for others to meet God. Jesus’ instructions can help us be life giving in our relationships.

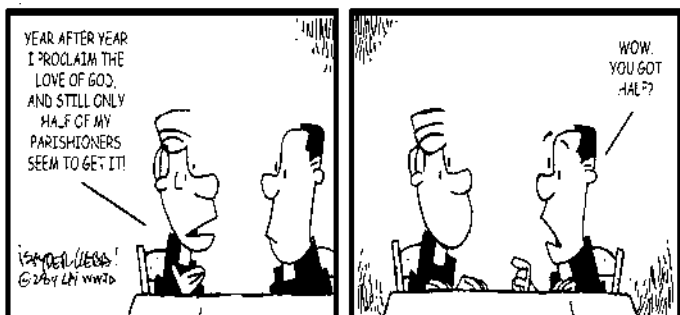
### MONDAY CLUB

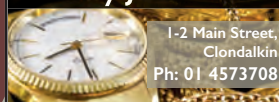
