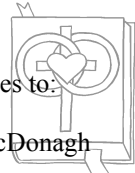

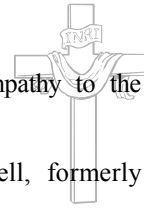

The Sacrament of Matrimony, paragraphs 1601-1690.
