

ST BLAISE AND BLESSING OF THROATS – MONDAY 3RD FEBRUARY

The first reference we have of him is in manuscripts of Aëtius Amidenus, a court physician at the end of the 5th or the beginning of the 6th century; there his aid is invoked in treating objects stuck in the throat.

According to the account, while Blaise was being taken into custody, a distraught mother, whose only child was choking on a fishbone, threw herself at his feet and implored his intercession. Touched at her grief, he offered up his prayers, and the child was cured. Consequently, Saint Blaise is invoked for protection against injuries and illnesses of the throat.

On Monday, 3rd February, the blessing of St. Blaise will be given here at 10am Mass only.

The blessing is given: "May Almighty God at the intercession of St. Blaise, Bishop and Martyr, preserve you from infections of the throat and from all other afflictions".
