# A BLESSING FOR EVERYONE AT ST. BRIGID'S WELL

Last Saturday, February 1<sup>st</sup>, the Feast day of St. Brigid, was the first time that I attended the blessing of a Holy Well dedicated to this great saint. I found the whole occasion to be an uplifting, faith-filled and joyful experience, despite the fact that the weather was wet and stormy.

For the occasion, Fr. Damian celebrated Mass at 10am, during which the St. Brigid's Crosses were blessed. I was honoured to assist as the Deacon and was delighted that so many of the students from the transition year of Coláiste Bríd were able to attend the Mass. Their generous participation certainly enhanced the liturgy by doing the readings, prayer of the faithful, presentation of the gifts, music and hymns. This all added to the celebration which leaves me with no doubt that St. Brigid will bless them abundantly during their studies and future ventures in life.

After the Mass, many of those who attended processed up to St. Brigid's Holy Well nearby, while others remained in the church to pray the rosary. In this way we were blessed to help each other in prayer and pilgrimage to the well.

As we huddled together under umbrellas and joined Fr. Damian in the blessing of the water, I was strengthened with the sense of community gathered together in faith. This small sanctuary, adorned with the symbols and signs of people's faith, medals, rosaries, cloths and statues, momentarily became a haven of peace, hope and blessings in what sometimes can appear a dull and hopeless world.

At one point, I noticed two passers-by who stopped to look on and take photos, and I wondered what they must have thought. To those without the eyes of faith, the world must often appear empty and flat. Our gathering at the well, may have appeared absurd and meaningless to some people but for us, "faith is being sure of what we hope for and certain of what we do not see" (Heb 11:1).
