work the hard part of child rearing is done and they can have an adult relationship with their sons or daughters.

No matter how old our children are they are still in our children. In my eight years ministry in Clondalkin the most difficult funerals are where parents mourn the loss of their child, whether the boy or girl is an infant, teenager, young adult or even where the 'child' is an adult and the parents have lived to a good age.

On Tuesday afternoon I heard the news reporting the collapse of a balcony in Berkley, California and that a number of Irish people were killed or injured. Immediately I wondered would I or any of us know some of them.

As I write this on Wednesday night I am hearing of parishioners whose children are friends, in the same courses, or members of the same sporting club as those who have died or are in hospital. It is a stark reminder of how small our island really is and the interconnected relationships we have. I'm sure there were many anxious moments for those awaiting news of their sons and daughters in California on their J-1 Visas. My friend Father Frank Herron (who used to say the Mass in Irish here) and is now Parish priest in Foxrock opened the Church to facilitate those who wished to gather their thoughts, express their sorrow or pray on Tuesday night. I pray that our Church will always be open to welcome people in good times and in bad just as the Parish in Foxrock opened its doors on Tuesday.

Eternal rest grant to all those who died in the tragedy and we continue to pray for those still recovering and their families and friends.


