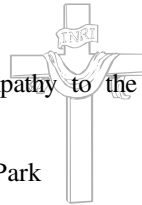

Vatican City, 31st October 2013, during a private audience with Cardinal Angelo Amato S.D.B., prefect of the Congregation for the Causes of Saints, Pope Francis authorised that Servant of God Honora "Nano" Nagle (John of God), Irish foundress of the Union of the Presentation Sisters of the Blessed Virgin Mary (1718-1784) be declared Venerable.
