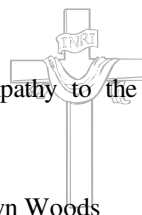

## INDULGENCES FOR THE HOLY SOULS DURING NOVEMBER

In our calendar year November is dedicated to the Holy Souls.

Throughout the month (and especially in the first eight days) the Church encourages her faithful to offer indulgences on behalf of the poor souls in purgatory.

The Church teaches that indulgences are granted to the dead by means of intercession.

To obtain the plenary indulgence on November 1-November 8, we visit a cemetery, receive Holy Communion and Confession. Communion must be received each day we wish to gain the indulgence, but we only need to go to Confession once during the period. And, as with all plenary indulgences, we must pray for the intentions of the Holy Father (one Our Father and one Hail Mary) each day we perform the work of the indulgence.

## "CARE TO DRIVE" TRANSPORT SERVICE

The Irish Cancer Society's 'Care to Drive' transport service is available for patients undergoing chemotherapy treatment in the Mater, St. Vincent's, St. James's, Tallaght & Blanchardstown hospitals. This service is completely free to the patient – a volunteer driver will pick you up at the door of your home and bring you to the hospital and then, after treatment, bring you home.
