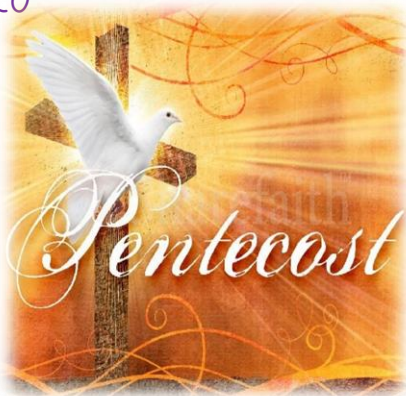

Let Jesus know where you truly are today!</p>	<p>5 <u>Easter Thursday</u> Lk 24:35-48 Jesus' first words to the disciples were "Peace be with you." Entrust to God all that does not bring peace.
