



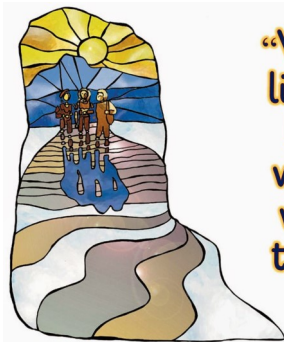
Sometimes things in our lives don't make sense to us. Even if we know God is at work, we might have a difficult time understanding what He might be doing.
