Praise God for the joyful things in your life. | 6 <i>Easter Tuesday</i> Jn 20:11-18 Today reflect on where you see the Risen Christ in the world around you, in the encounters with others? | 7 <i>Easter Wednesday</i> Lk 24:13-35 Jesus walks with the disciples on the road to Emmaus where they are at, not where he would like or expect them to be. Let Jesus know where you truly are today! | 8 <i>Easter Thursday</i> Lk 24:35-48 Jesus' first words to the disciples were "Peace be with you." Entrust to God all that does not bring peace. Say a prayer for Peace in our world today. | 9 <i>Easter Friday</i> Jn 21:1-14 Who is the Christ you are looking for? How would you recognize him as he stands among you? | 10 <i>Easter Saturday</i> Mk 16:9-15 Mark's summary of the Resurrection encounters seems to rush to the key point, He is Risen and this IS Good News!! |
| 11 <i>Divine Mercy Sunday</i> Jn 20:19-31 Mercy is love in action, Love that dispels all fear. How are we being witnesses to that Mercy & Love in our Church, family, communities & world today? | 12 Jn 3:1-8 We are born again of love and the Spirit | 13 Jn 3:7-15 We can either live in the shadows of others or we can break away and live in the light of the Lord.
