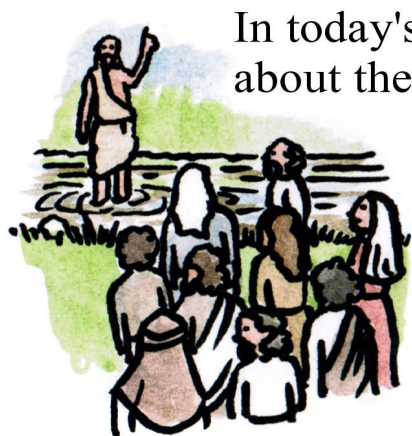
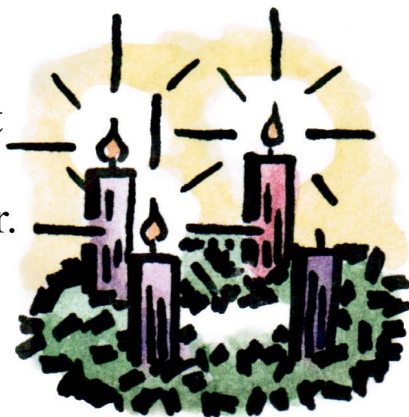


Painting the Way to Jesus

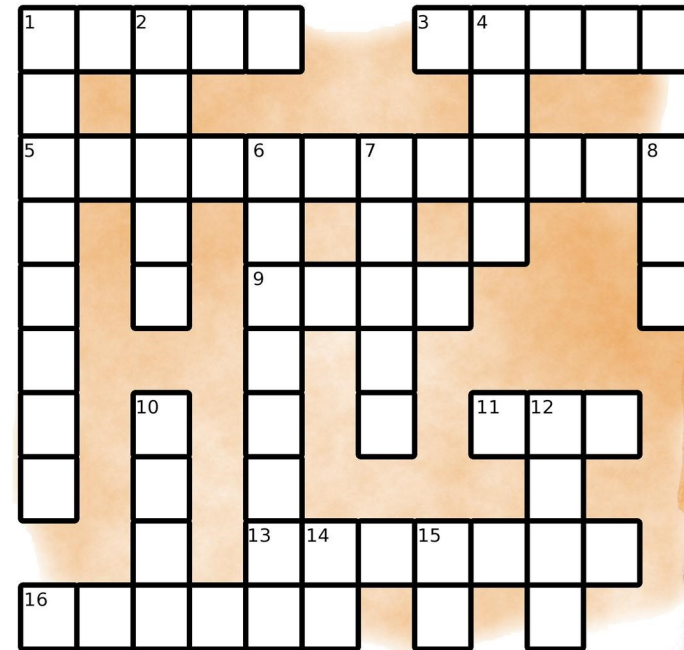
Saint John of the Cross
